Be sure to use the highest quality English when submitting your paper to EasyChair. You are writing for an international audience interested primarily in various aspects of educational technology. We intend to publish papers. Be sure to carefully proofread your manuscript and have it grammatically correct, following APA guidelines.

Be sure to register for the conference (see <http://seminars.unj.ac.id/etwc/>) by April 15, 2016. Papers accepted by those who do not register will not be included in the Proceedings nor be candidates for inclusion in the edited volume being planned based on expanded versions of conference papers.

Please submit your completed paper to the EasyChair. Please also send a copy of the paper to Muchlas Suseno (muchlas-suseno@unj.ac.id) and/or Mike Spector (mike.spector@unt.edu) as an email attachment so that the organizers can Website for the conference - login at <https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=etwc2016>. Submission of the paper to EasyChair is a requirement.

Papers should be:

1. In grammatically correct English, double-spaced in TMR 12 font, and formatted according to APA 6 guidelines (see guidelines).
2. Submitted as a PDF to EasyChair with a DOC, DOCX, or RTF email attachment to Suseno and Spector.
3. Between 2,500 - 4,000 words in length including references; references must follow APA 6 reference guidelines.
4. Submitted to the EasyChair site no later than April 15, 2016, midnight, GMT.
